Environmental Policy

We, the TEEKANNE Group, consider it our corporate duty to take responsibility for our environment and are working towards making our business activities environmentally friendly.

Sustainability is firmly anchored in our corporate strategy and from this we derive the following points for our actions:

- The sustainability management of the group and also the cross-locational workgroup "sustainability" carries the environmental protection concept into all functions and departments of the company.
- We strive for the greatest possible recycling of our waste and recyclable materials and work closely with regional waste management companies.
- Through our numerous certified raw materials and packaging materials (e.g. Rainforest Alliance and FSC) we contribute to the preservation of biodiversity, sustainable cultivation and the preservation of soil fertility.
- TEEKANNE Group will voluntarily establish an environmental monitoring system and continuously developing it further. The system includes the monitoring of key environmental indicators (e.g. emissions, energy, water and recyclables).
- At our site in Düsseldorf, we have established an energy management system in accordance with DIN EN ISO 50001 to monitor our activities and set ourselves ambitious energy targets.
- Through our corporate communications (e.g. via the sustainability management or training courses), we regularly inform our teams about environmentally relevant key figures and projects within the company.
- For interested parties (such as our customers, authorities, or NGOs), we provide information about the environmental impact of the TEEKANNE Group and our environmental performance.
